I'm imploring your help. My fiancé, Ryan, and I have 4 young children, ages 5-9. Since Pennsylvania's Governor Wolf's decision to shut down new construction we are set to be homeless on April 20! We have a Lennar home that was expected to be delivered on that day in Hidden Meadows, Perkasio, PA. There is a pending agreement of sale on my current home on that day as well. Our buyers have not agreed to extend our contract and are forcing us out of our current home. I'm worrying endlessly about how we will be able to find a safe clean rental home and how will we afford that extra expense - which will more than double the expected cost. This is all occurring as I'm under-employed because of the shutdowns and as I am losing half of my usual income. I'm asking you to please appeal Governor Wolf's decision on behalf of our family of six. To us, the delivery of our new home is life-sustaining! It is shelter for us and is imperative to our health and protection from COVID-19. Our home is less 30 days away from delivery - only needing a few items before it is completed. Please help us appeal for a waiver so that Lennar can finish our family home.
