

# COVID-19 Risk Level Scenarios

POLICY EFFECTIVE MARCH 14<sup>th</sup>

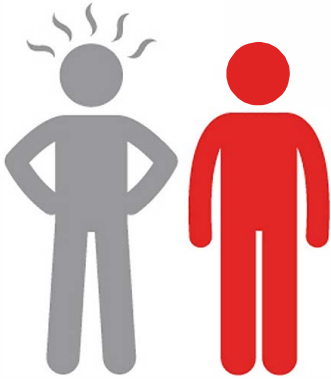
## CDC TYPICAL SYMPTOMS:

- Coughing (frequent, dry or productive/wet cough)
- Fever  $\geq$  100.5 Fahrenheit
- Breathlessness (shortness of breath)

## OTHER SYMPTOMS:

- Low Fever
- Sneezing
- Sore Throat

## DIRECT CONTACT



*Close interaction with a COVID-19 patient within 14 days*

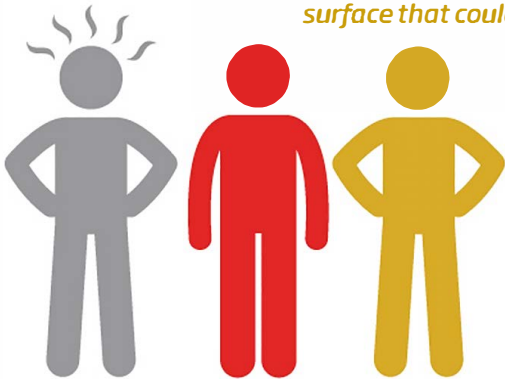
- An Associate, with or without typical symptoms, had direct contact with COVID-19 patient
- An Associate, with or without contact with COVID-19 patient, is sick (with typical cough and/or fever and/or shortness of breath)

### Result:

**14 day quarantine and testing for COVID-19**

*If either the patient or Associate's COVID-19 test is negative, or if the assigned quarantine period is completed, and symptoms have subsided, the Associate will be able to return to work.*

## INDIRECT CONTACT



*Contact with someone who had contact with COVID-19 within 14 days, or contact with surface that could be infected by COVID-19 patients within 14 days*

- An Associate had indirect contact with COVID-19 patient
- An Associate with other symptoms

### Result:

**7 day quarantine (and testing for COVID-19, whenever it becomes available in the US for this category)**

*If either the patient or Associate's COVID-19 test is negative, or if the assigned quarantine period is completed, and symptoms have subsided, the Associate will be able to return to work.*

## CONTACT WITH INDIRECT CONTACT

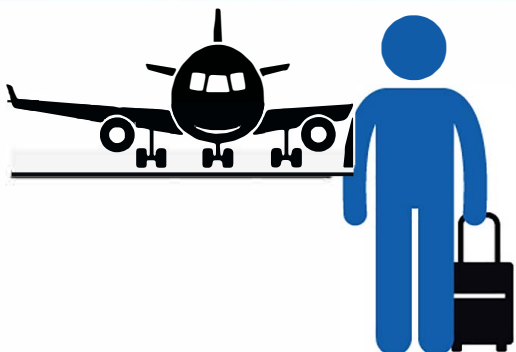


- If you are in contact with someone who had indirect contact, the recommendation is for no quarantine

### Result:

**No quarantine, no test;  
continue good prevention of COVID-19**

## TRAVEL



- An Associate returns from international travel
- An Associate returns from a cruise

### Result:

**14 day quarantine**

- An Associate returns from commercial domestic air travel

### Result:

**4 day quarantine**
